Appointment of Kaihautū

Ngā Tāngata Tiaki o Whanganui is excited to announce that Nancy Tuaine has been confirmed as our new Kaihautū (Chief Executive) and will commence work in the role on Monday 31 May 2021.

Nancy is well known within the iwi and has been involved with the Awa for several years. In recent years Nancy has worked in the public sector at a senior management level, has been the CE of Te Oranganui, and has worked as a consultant.

The Kaihautu role was advertised in mid-March following the resignation of Ray Hall for family reasons. Following a robust process, which included management of the Kaihautū recruitment process by an agency, and the appointment of an independent panel member, Nancy was offered the role.

While we are sorry to lose Nancy as a Trustee, we are excited for the contribution she will make as Kaihautū. Nancy has always been committed to the health and wellbeing of the Awa and our people and with the wealth of iwi and central government experience she brings to the Kaihautū role, has much to offer the Trust, operational staff and hapū of Whanganui toward the same ends.
